

QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION FACT SHEET

A qualified charitable distribution (QCD) may be used as a convenient, tax-free way to make gifts up to \$105,000* per year to Best Friends Animal Society or other qualified charitable organizations, while satisfying IRA required minimum distributions.



HERE ARE SOME KEY QCD FEATURES:

- You must be 70 ½ years of age or older.
- You may transfer up to \$105,000* per year directly from your IRA to Best Friends or other qualified charitable organizations.
- Married couples can gift up to \$105,000* per person, per year, from their IRA if each meets the requirements above. Other gift limitations apply; please contact us for details.
- You may not receive any goods or services in return for your gift.
- You may use your QCD to fund a life income gift, such as a charitable gift annuity.

^{*} For gifts made in 2024. Maximum gift limits are scheduled to increase in coming years.
